### Requirements:

Must submit the following by the deadline

- Entry Form
- Entry Fee (Miss Photogenic is additional \$10 or waived if you raise \$100)
- 2 – 4x6 photos; The photos can be black & white or color. If entering in Miss Photogenic photo will need to be a full faced. (Photos need to be labeled on the back; 1 – for the program and 1 – Miss Photogenic, if applicable with paid \$10 fee)
- Emcee Card – Please print clearly

You must attend the mandatory meeting for instructions on Thursday, May 11 at 5:00 PM at Central National Bank Center.

Contestants are encouraged to dress in their best attire. Pageant, Christmas, party dress or church dresses. Make sure all attire; hair, and makeup are age appropriate!

Winners agree to return to help hand out awards for the Roberts Ranch Smokin Red Dirt BBQ and March of Dimes activities during but not limited to April and December. Schedules will be distributed at the pageant. All winners will be recognized at the BBQ awards but only the winner from the Teen division will be required to help with handing out awards.

Overall winners receive a crown and sash. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will receive a flower.

### Additional Awards:

1. **Miss Photogenic** (This award is optional) If you choose to participate the fee is \$10.00. This fee will be waived if you raise \$100.00 or more. There will be a winner for Miss Photogenic in each age division. You will need to submit a full faced photo labeled Miss Photogenic on the back for this competition
2. **People's Choice Award** – You will need to submit a decorated shoe box (no larger than a man's shoe box). These will need to be brought to the mandatory rehearsal. This category is based on the contestants with the highest donations from the audience the day of the pageant. NOTE: No donation will be turned away; however, money has to be counted the night of the event so loose coins will not be counted towards the

contestant's total on the night of the event. Cash and checks (made payable to the March of Dimes) will be counted towards the contestant's total.

**3. Shining Star Award** – Winner will be the contestant that turns in the most money raised by ad sales, donations and other fundraisers. All money must be turned in by Monday, May 8, 2017.
